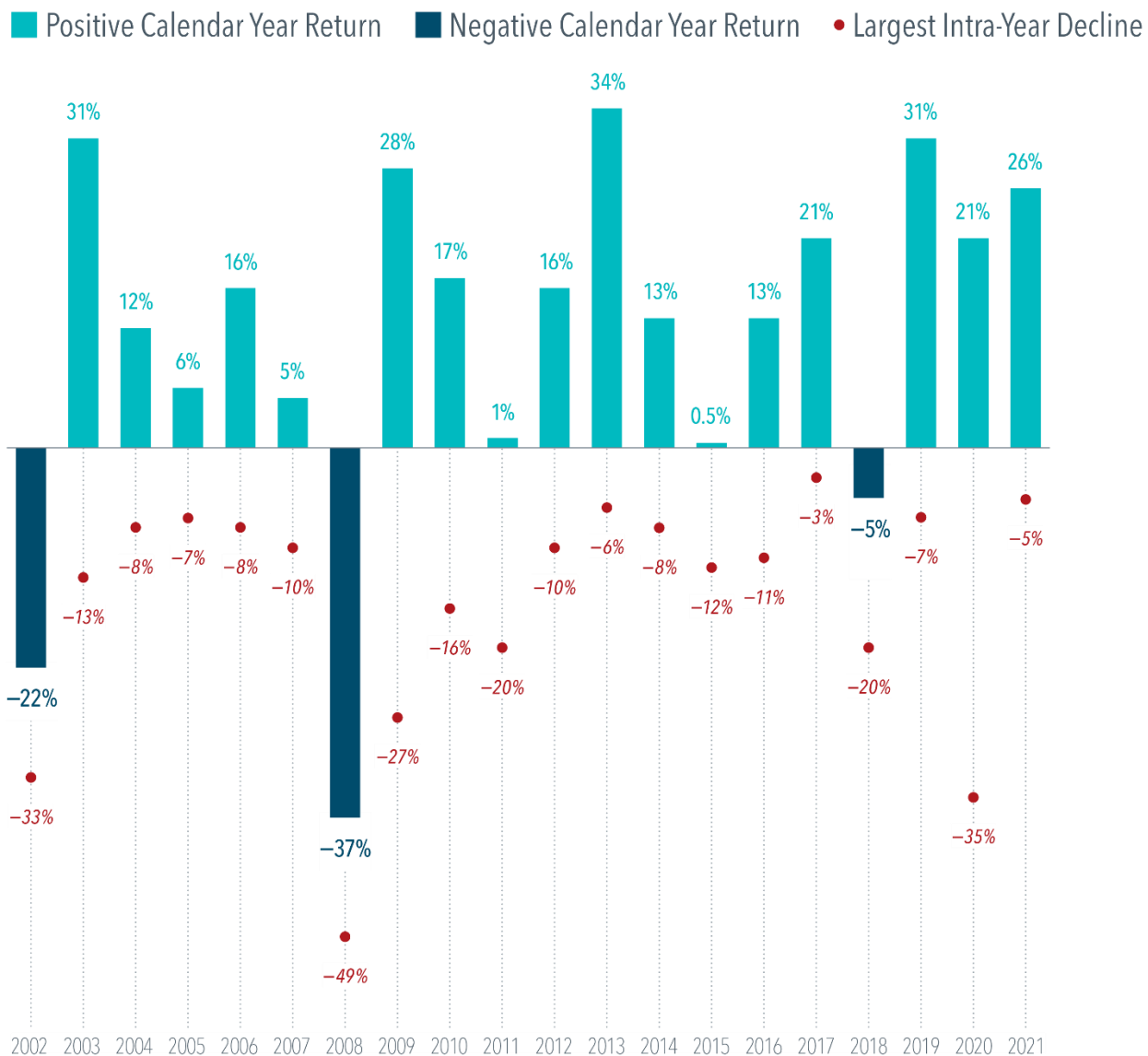


U.S. Stock Returns by Year and Largest Intra-Year Decline 2002 – 2021
